What we have seen is a monstrous attack on the fundamental values underlying democratic stability, and economic and social well-being. Despite this great shock, these events must not be allowed to destabilise economic activity and confidence. The business community, in the USA, in Europe and elsewhere, must do all that it can to ensure that disruption is as short-lived as possible. I am confident that we can meet this challenge."
