Article 13: The coordination of economic policies

- The Union shall coordinate the economic policies of the Member States, in particular by establishing broad guidelines for these policies.
- 2. The Member States shall conduct their economic policies, taking account of the common interest, so as to contribute to the achievement of the objectives of the Union.
- Specific provisions shall apply to those Member States which have adopted the euro.

Article 13: The coordination of economic policies

- 1. Member States shall coordinate their economic policies within the EU, in particular by establishing broad guidelines for these policies.
- 2. The Member States shall conduct their economic policies, taking account of the common interest, so as to contribute to the achievement of the objectives of the Union.
- Specific provisions shall apply to those Member States which have adopted the euro.

Explanation:

First paragraph: this is to stick to the spirit of articles 98/99 of the EC Treaty, which should not be changed. It should be recalled that the final report of Working Group on Economic Governance (CONV357/02), as endorsed by the Convention Plenary, did not present any ma-

jority view on the need to change existing arrangements for the current Broad Economic Policy Guidelines process, with the exception of giving the European Parliament the right of formal consultation on the draft BEPG.
