THE EUROPEAN COMPANY STATUTE: A COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE?

켜 Objectives

Further to the seminar UNICE organised in October 2004, the date of the entry into force of the European legislation creating a European Company Statute (*societas europeae* or SE), UNICE considers it is time to take stock of where we stand some eighteen months later.

On 31 May 2006, UNICE is organising a seminar on the SE Statute to hear directly from companies why they decided to (or not to) go for the SE Statute and to assess with specialists whether such a statute is a competitive advantage for companies in Europe.

The public declarations by certain companies that they would adopt the SE Statute have prompted UNICE to find out directly from market players (panel 1) why they have chosen to adopt the Statute – what are the decisive advantages that makes or could make the SE Statute the right choice for them?

Given the current economic environment (European business competing in a global environment, an increasing number of mergers and acquisitions, economic patriotism and current debates on national, European, and/or global champions) we would like to explore (panel 2) with participants whether the SE Statute is the appropriate tool for strengthening European business competitiveness. Is the SE Statute an option for SMEs? If not, what should be the alternative?

- Participants shall be representatives of companies, business organisations, representatives, Member States and Members of the European Parliament. All will have the opportunity to ask questions to the panel of experts and provide their own views.
