




AUTUMN 2007 REFORM BAROMETER: ANSWERS FROM BIA (BULGARIA)

(Average progress is weighted by reform priorities)


0.00: deteriorating

0.25: unsatisfactory


0.50: neither unsatisfactory, nor satisfactory

0.75: satisfactory 1.00: excellent




