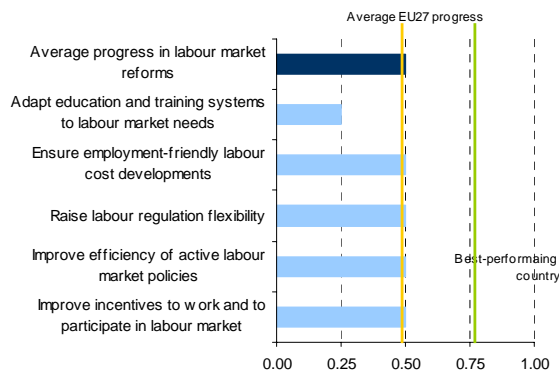

REFORM PROGRESS IN FOUR MAJOR POLICY AREAS:

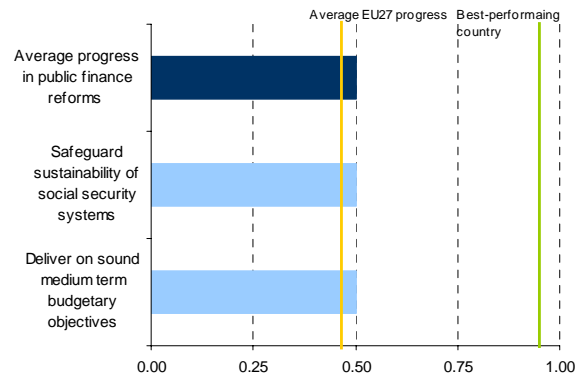

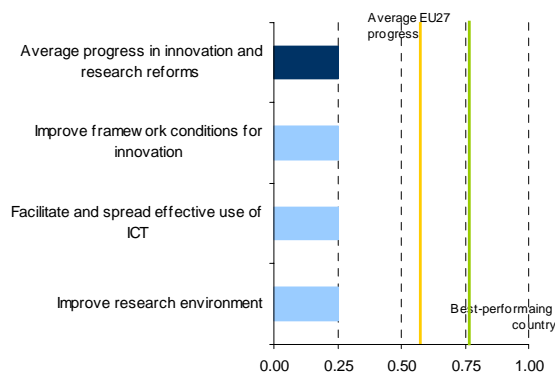

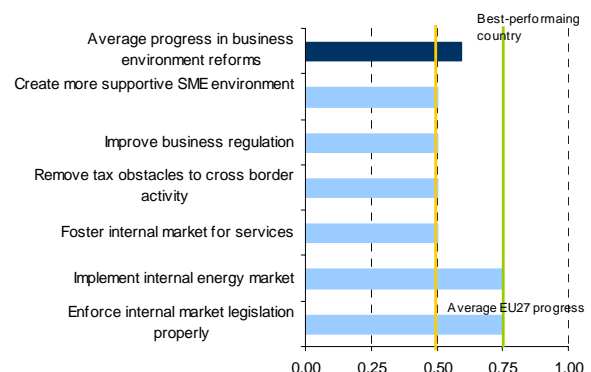
