






## **AUTUMN 2007 REFORM BAROMETER: ANSWERS FROM DA AND DI (DENMARK)**

## **REFORM PROGRESS IN FOUR MAJOR POLICY AREAS:**


(Average progress is weighted by reform priorities)

0.25: unsatisfactory


0.50: neither unsatisfactory, nor satisfactory

0.75 satisfactory 1.00: excellent




