

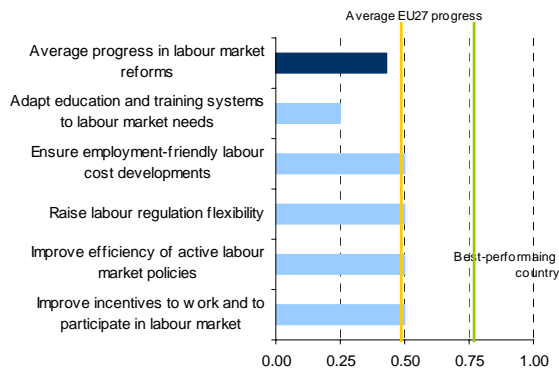

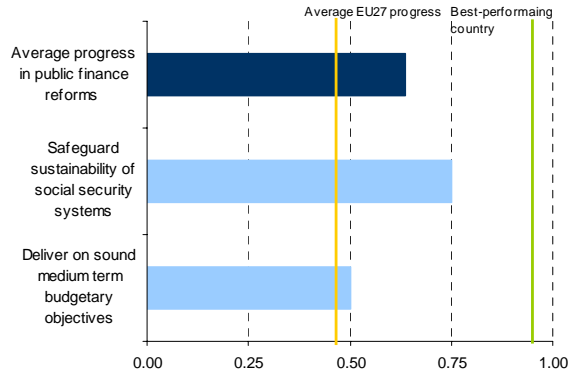
REFORM PROGRESS IN FOUR MAJOR POLICY AREAS:

 1.00: *excellent*

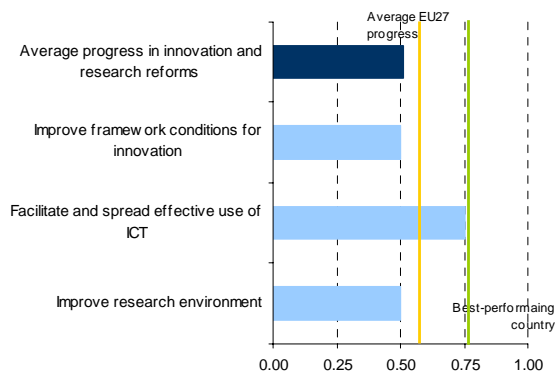

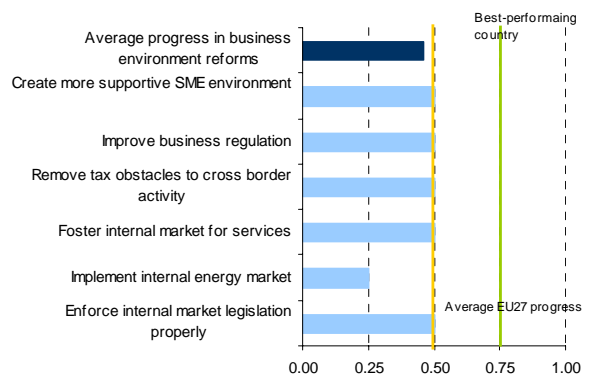
