Lifelong Learning:

A precondition
for employment security

LLL and job security

- No guarantee for job security in a dynamic economy
- Development of stronger competencies will secure employability for every EU-citizen!

Public policy

The challenge for the public policy:

- To provide competencies that better correspond to the need of the labour market: Requires better adaptation of the national education systems
- To secure better competencies for each EU-citizen: Increase ability to change employment/change profession in a globalized world

What to do?

- Within the Lisbon strategy to develop national strategies with emphasis on:
 - Provide better basic skills as a necessary foundation for LLL
 - Strong involvement of the social partners in the development of education programmes
 - Increased public and private investments in LLL
 - Improvement for guidance and counselling to support participation in LLL
 - Upgrading of competencies for those with the lowest level of education – shared responsibility
