NEW RULES OF ORIGIN – Another Trade Barrier for European Traders?



The aim of the Modernised Customs Code (MCC) is to simplify the customs procedure and to cut costs for businesses. However, new non-preferential rules of origin based on list rules would not accomplish this objective. Changing the existing rules could create new and unnecessary bureaucratic costs for exports without added-value benefits for European businesses. Rules of origin should be kept as simple as possible in the interests of European business. We want to share the position of European companies with Members of the European Parliament and representatives of the European Commission.
