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Business-friendly environment: A and Z factor for investment

- Need for regulatory reforms
- Progress but challenges remain
 - → dialogue with local/national authorities
 - → dialogue between businesses





- Red tape reduction
 - → starting a business: time consuming, complex procedure

- Creation of synergies between policies
 - → reforms in business regulations more likely to succeed if rules for trade, labour, IPR and anti-corruption are in place

- Assist in the adoption of good practices
- Become the intermediary between national authorities and businesses





Suggestion:

- Take stock of the crisis
 - → the crisis has not stopped the reform process
 - → regulatory reforms boost growth over medium term
